A simple service recalling the events of this dark day

8:30 p.m.

The First Celebration of Easter.

This is the oldest and most joyful of all the liturgies of the church, dating back to the first records we have of worship in the 2nd century.

We begin in darkness, tell ancient stories of salvation, and move to the first light and "alleluia!" of Easter.
